This National Summit on Urban Aboriginal Housing will provide a forum where we can learn about developments in other provinces and territories regarding federal funding under Bill C-48. The Summit will showcase progressive funding arrangements and accountability models as these currently exist or are being developed in various provinces and territories across Canada. Representatives from the provinces of British Columbia, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Québec and New Brunswick will join Urban Aboriginal Housing corporations in their respective regions to make presentations on action underway to move funding forward.

There will also be a presentation on federal funding to help combat homelessness, as well as a panel on Homelessness made up of representatives from the NAFC, NWAC and Lu'ma Native Housing Society (Vancouver).

- a model (framework) to ensure delivery in a consistent way of non-reserve Aboriginal housing programs across Canada;
- concurrence that Aboriginal housing programs are delivered by Aboriginal persons for Aboriginal persons;
- adoption by participants from all provinces and regions of some of the best practices demonstrated at the Summit;
- development of strategies to facilitate increased cooperation among all organizations that have a stake in Aboriginal housing.
